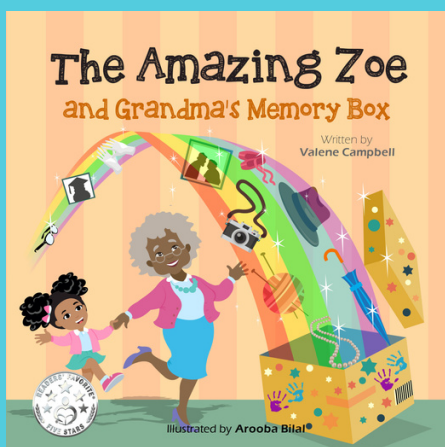

OUR PROGRAM

Students will receive a dynamic read-aloud from your choice of The Amazing Zoe book series. Afterwards, we will open a dialogue about the main message of each book, the importance of tolerance and diverse literature, and anti-racial bullying.. We will end with an interactive Afro-Caribbean-inspired dance-along session that introduces the history and cultural references of each art form. We will also discuss steps of how students can become an author. (75 min)

POPULAR PLANS
